



## Cost

Our community training is provided by medical and professional consultants who are caregivers and serve individuals living with autism and related special needs in their profession. Our training is charged at an hourly rate of \$150.00 per hour. We will work with organizations of every budget to meet the educational needs of your staff. Once a cost is determined, a contract will be created and half this cost will be due prior to the educational event. The second half is due once training is complete, on the day of the event. For pro-bono training, we will provide an invoice for estimated mileage. This will be due one week prior to educational event.
